### **About BUYA**

BUYA was established to unify the Bay Area's successful YCC and winter youth club teams (Cali Roll and Gold Rush) under a single USAU affiliate organization. Our goal is to support the highly motivated youth of the Bay Area to achieve excellence on the field as players while empowering them to grow as leaders. We view success as giving players the tools and role models they need to become leaders and community builders in their own right.

Our mission is to invest in individual growth, cultivate community-oriented thinking, and build a more inclusive and healthy future for our youth.

### **About YCC**

The Youth Club Championships (YCC) is a national youth tournament that brings together the nation's best youth club teams to Blaine, Minnesota to compete for a national title. The event hosts teams in an under-20 boys', girls' and mixed divisions and an under-17 boys' and girls' divisions.

Beginning in 2010, the Bay Area began sending their own all-star teams to this tournament and claimed gold three times—most recently in 2017, when the Happy Cows were crowned champions of the U20 Mixed division. Additionally, Belly of the Beast, the U17 girls team, won the Team Spirit Award in 2018.

### **About the position**

The YCC Assistant Coach is responsible for assisting in the design and development of the season plan and helping implement the head coach's plans by providing assistance during tryouts, practices, scrimmages, and games. Assistant Coaches will help the head coach with all administrative duties and parent communications, as well as putting their skills and knowledge of the game in service to the team.

### **Qualifications**

- Prior experience coaching ultimate.
- Has knowledge and background playing ultimate.
- Excellent organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills.

### **Responsibilities**

- Be a role model for players.
- Assist in the creation of the season plan, tryouts, practice sessions, pod workouts, and games.
- Attend YCC Coaches Meetings.

- Provide input into the team selection process.
- Promote individual growth in athletic skills, teamwork, discipline, respect, and spirit of the game.
- Work with team leadership and provide support.
- Take all necessary precautions to protect players, equipment, and facilities, including protecting players from hazing/bullying.
- Attend and support the minimum 30 minute conference with parents/guardians to talk about the season plan.
- Attend coaching development meetings, clinics, and other professional activities to improve coaching performance.
- Attend the end-of-season review evaluation (phone call)

### **Commitment**

- Teams will practice at least once every weekend from the first weekend of June to the last weekend of July. Additional practices are to be determined at the head coaches' discretion. Assistant Coaches are expected to attend at least 5 of the 8 weekend practices.
- Assistant Coaches are expected to attend YCC from August 3rd to the 7th.
- Assistant Coaches are expected to attend at least one team bonding event, the conversation/training on diversity, equity and inclusion, and the annual YCC fundraiser.
